Daily Student and Staff Screening Tool

All MUASD parents are asked to screen their student(s) before school **each day**.

All staff are asked to perform self-screening each day before reporting to work.

This tool has been adapted from the Pennsylvania Dept. of Health.

Complete this quick checklist each day before reporting to school.

Staff or students should stay home if you:

- Have one or more symptoms in Group A **OR**
- Have two or more symptoms in Group B **OR**
- Are taking fever reducing medication.

Group A 1 or more symptoms	Group B 2 or more symptoms
Cough Shortness of breath Difficulty breathing New loss of sense of smell New loss of sense of taste	Fever Chills Rigors Myalgia Headache Sore throat Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea Fatigue Congestion or runny nose

You should contact your doctor or the Pennsylvania Department of Health for guidance if you are experiencing any of the above symptoms and you:

Had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19.

Traveled to an area with a high transmission rate

Staff and Students should not return to school until fever-free for a period of 24 hours without an anti-fever medicine.

Staff – report off on the Employee Portal and contact your building office if you are calling off after 6:30 AM.

There is a symptom checker on CDC that you may want to check.
